Each teacher met with Liz throughout the day to discuss their planning, grouping, target students, etc. and Liz took our Staff Hui after school, a session on Orthographic Mapping - the process our brains use to store words in long term memory so we can retrieve them for accurate reading and spelling. A message from Liz: Many thanks for today allowing each teacher to have their allocated time with me to unravel some challenges, explore their positives and consider the next steps. It's a good time for me as well to judge where everyone is knowledge wise and with their teaching.

them in the box at the school office. Also, please keep collecting your Yummy Stickers. If you have filled up your sheet, please bring it in to the school office and get a new one.




RIMU & MANUKA ARTWORK
