PRINCIPAL'S MESSAGE

Here we are back in COVID-19 Level 2 again, a whole year since the first case of the virus was confirmed in New Zealand. These moves through the levels will undoubtedly unsettle some children again. Just to reiterate our precautions at this level ...

- At the school gate: Students are not allowed on site until 8.30am. At 3.00pm, parents need to wait outside the school gates and the children will be brought out to you. If you come onto the school grounds for any reason, you must either come into the office and sign in, or use the COVID app tracer. Please try and limit your time coming into the grounds.
- We have altered the play/eat time again at interval and lunchtime so we can manage handwashing before eating.
- Please all bring a water bottle to school as the drinking fountains have been covered. There is a tap on the side of the fountains to refill water bottles.
- Under Alert Level 2, we advise any students and staff to stay at home if they are sick, and we will send anyone home immediately if they show any symptoms.
- We are still allowed to use the school pool for school and community use.
- Advice from the Ministry of Education: Under the COVID-19 Public Health Response Order, schools exempted from physical are distancing requirements when people are there to receive, provide, or support education services. For most day-to-day activities at schools, the rules for gatherings will therefore not apply. Other health measures must however be in place including appropriate physical distancing (at Alert Level 2 for students – not touching each other and giving some breathing space; for adults 1 metre from other adults when practicable), hand washing, staying away if sick, contact tracing systems and regularly cleaning and disinfecting high touch surfaces.


